### Chicago Branch Expands



Roughly a year ago, the Chicago branch acquired the neighboring building to help in our continued effort to grow as well as providing assistance to the Indianapolis and Minnesota branches. With the increase in material and new products we are now stocking more to better serve our customers. Our inventory dollars went from approximately 650,000.00 to 1,000,000.000 and our total square footage went from 8,050 to 16,205 square feet.

The warehouse transformation was a three month laborious effort by all parties involved including our president Jim Bokor Jr. who designed the layout. He made several visits to help with construction and the relocation of our existing pipe rack. Demolition of partial walls occurred to join the two warehouses and offices together. Our Buffalo facility provided us with additional shelving and cantilever racks to accompany our increase in PVF.

In June of 2011, we expanded our sales territory to the Rocky Mountains and hired Jeff Gorrell out of Colorado to our sales team, and then in October we added Michael Ross to inside sales. We also added Ray Miller to our warehouse and recently Victoria Maraldo to our clerical staff. An additional pick-up truck was added to our fleet, all in an effort to improve our service to our customers.
